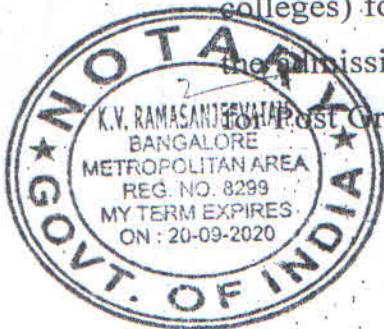
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**N.B:** The report of the local enquiry committee for the year 2019-20 will be sent through **E-mail**. Recognition has been renewed with respect to the number of students prescribed by the University. The College has to file follow up/adopted report regarding improvements taken by rectifying the deficits mentioned as "0" (Zero) in the local enquiry committee within 30 days. As otherwise the application for renewal of recognition for the academic year 2020-21 will not be accepted.

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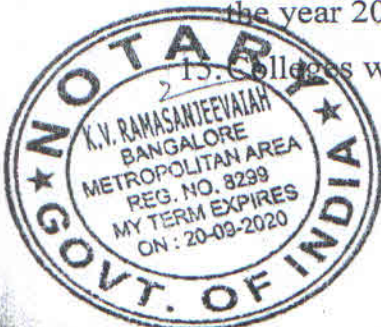
**\* Conditions:**

1. Has to follow the conditions mentioned in the local enquiry committee.
2. If in case the prescribed number for admission is exceeded, the University will not give recognition for admission of additional students.
3. Should not increase branches for any course/courses without prior permission of the University.
4. Has to strictly follow the **orders** of the government proclaimed from time to time regarding **reservation** at the time of admission of students to the said degree courses.
5. College has to follow the orders, rules/regulations proclaimed by the University with respect to students, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. The college has to admit the students for the courses without violating eligibility regulations prescribed for the course by the University and also without exceeding the number of students prescribed for the courses as per the University Recognition Notification.
6. Has to admit 50% of prescribed number of students (100% for government colleges) for the students sponsored by the University and without exceeding the admission and other fee as prescribed by the University from time to time for Post Graduate courses.



7. There is no opportunity to issue admission to excess of students which number exceeds more than number of students prescribed in Bangalore Central University Departments for the Post Graduate Courses.
8. Any type of harassment, sexual harassment to any women/female students committed by any person (teaching/non-teaching staff/Management) or any student at the working places or office or college is an offence made punishable as per the decision of **Supreme Court of India dated: 13/08/1997 in case Vaishakha v/s State of Rajasthan.** If any person/student is participated in such activities, such persons shall be debarred from the post/studentship. The College has to establish the complaint committee as per the order of the Supreme Court of India in order to curb/stop such crimes/activities.
9. The college has to improve its educational curriculum/syllabus in order to educationally improve the students. The Principal/The Management have to look after the students and teaching staff with kindness/compassion.
10. The college shall not withhold the Marks card and other documents of the student without any reason for more than six months. The college shall have to return the Marks Card and other documents which are filed for their approval immediately after approval of their admission and has to report the same to the University.
11. The College has to give Transfer Certificate without giving any trouble to the students who have applied for Transfer Certificate. As per the rules there is no permission for collection of additional fee apart from Tuition/Teaching Fee for the incomplete period with respect to that Academic Year/Semester.
12. The College shall not collect any capitation fee.
13. Kannada Language shall compulsorily be used in administrative affairs.
14. College has to file application for renewal of recognition of the courses for the year 2020-21 without fail.

15. Colleges which have completed 5 years have to obtain approval from NAAC.



16. The Principal has to submit list of competent features for valuation work to the concerned Presidents of the Examination Boards, otherwise the recognition of the College will be cancelled.

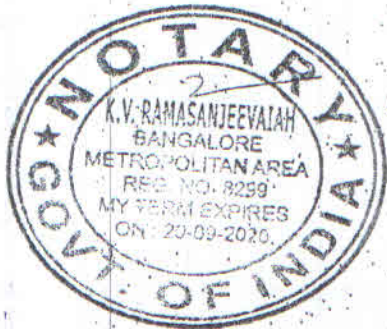
